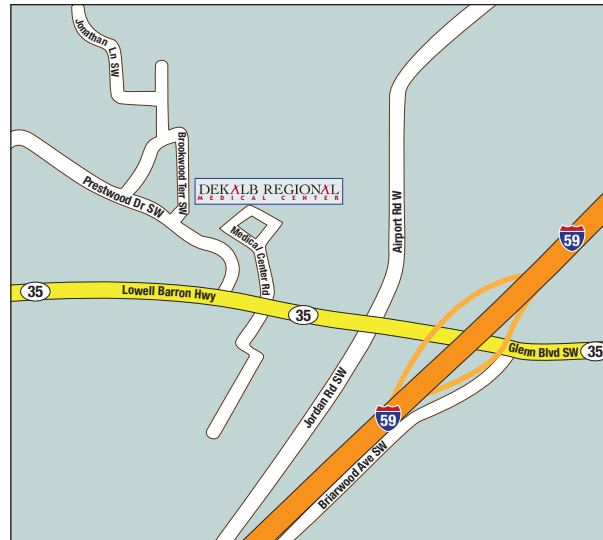
### Directions:
